Gender Summit 11 Declaration

- Institutional systemic change:
 - Intentionality, diversity in leadership, monitor & report
 - Individual to collective (organizational) level
- Strengthen research & innovation communities
 - Training & awareness, removal of barriers, access to full pool of talent
- Increase the social relevance & impact of research and innovation
 - EDI in research design, broader understandings of research excellence, multi-stakholder approach

Fonds de recherche du Québec (FRQ)

- Endorsement of the Gender Summit 11 Declaration
- Implementation of the SAGA project with UNESCO
- Creation of a new position to integrate EDI in FRQ's policies and programs
- Commitment to the use of a narrative CV
- Consideration as to how an Athena SWAN-like program could be implemented, in collaboration with relevant provincial ministries, the federal granting agencies, Universities Canada and other stakeholders

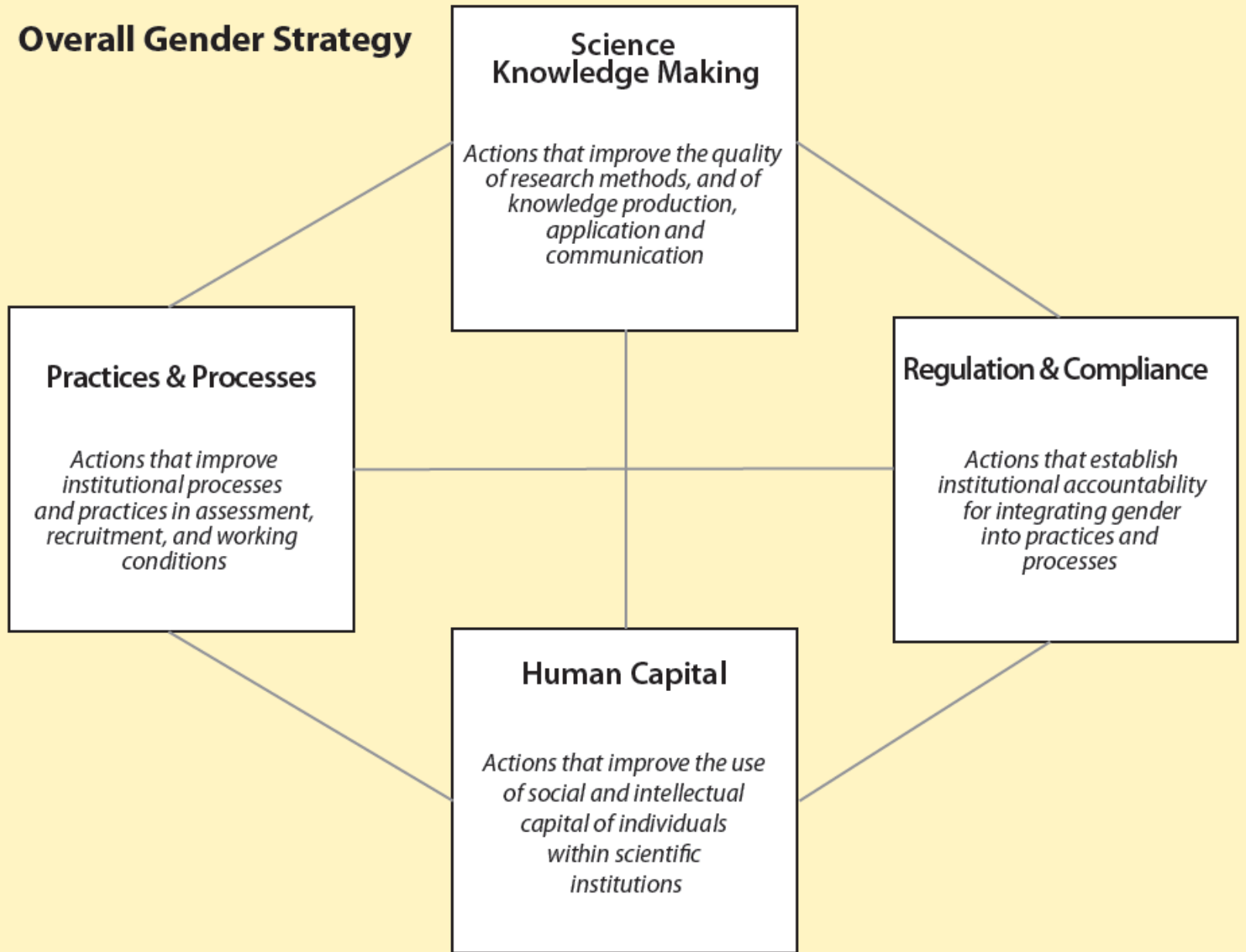
Gender Summit 2011-2017
